

# LONDON TO PARIS CYCLE

Dale Thomas of Lewis Civil Engineering successfully completed the London to Paris sponsored cycle ride raising much needed funds for 'Cost of Cancer'.

The event, organised by Global Adventure Challenges saw 80 riders cycle 314 miles from London to Paris over 4 days. The route went through the glorious English countryside, to the ferry from Dover to Calais. Once in France, cycling continued along quiet French country lanes, through traditional market towns with views of the rolling green hills of Northern France. The finish line was the within the spectacular view of the 324 metre Eiffel Tower in central Paris.

Dale was one of a group of six riders representing the charity 'Cost of Cancer', a local South Wales based charity set up to help people with the expensive costs of living with cancer. Dale raised a fantastic £1,800 for the charity.

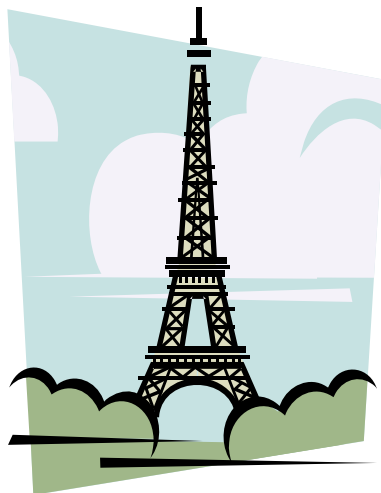
